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TRIP DETAILS WHERE TO BE AND WHEN

Our tour begins and ends in Las Vegas, Nevada. You're responsible for being at the pickup location (listed below) by 11am on the start date of your trip.

START OF TRIP PICKUP LOCATION

Las Vegas International Airport, Nevada. If you're staying in Las Vegas, we'll do our best to accommodate dropping you off at your hotel.

PICKUP TIME: 11:00AM

DROPOFF TIME: 12:00PM

TRIP ITINERARY

DAY I: DEPART LAS VEGAS

We'll pick you up in Las Vegas at 11am and kick off the National Park Tour experience with a volunteer project with the folks at the Clean the World in Las Vegas. This is a great way to get to know everyone on the trip and give back in the process. Then, enjoy epic views as we drive to Zion National Park.

DAY 2: ZION NATIONAL PARK

We'll spend the morning volunteering with the National Park Service. The project will vary based on their needs at the time. This is a great behind-thescenes look at what the National Park Rangers do on a daily basis. After doing good, we'll cool off in one of our favorite swimming holes followed by a short, but epic hike.

DAY 3: BRYCE CANYON

We'll kick off the morning with a big breakfast and drive to Bryce Canyon. After taking in some sweeping views, we'll complete a 4-mile round trip hike where you'll be rewarded with some of the most amazing landscapes in the country.

Afterward, we'll head back to our place and enjoy some rest and relaxation. Hot tub, anyone?

TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 4: JAM-PACKED DAY

An early morning wakeup takes us to the picturesque, Lower Antelope Canyon. This place will not disappoint. After working up a bit of a sweat, we'll head to the refreshing waters of Lake Powell for some floating, swimming and drinks (if you're into that). WILL WE STOP AT A GROCERY STORE?

Yes. You'll have the chance to pick up snacks and booze en route to Zion National Park on day one of the trip.

DO YOU NEED TO STAY AT THE PICKUP LOCATION HOTEL?

No. You can stay wherever you'd like. We just ask that you arrive promptly by 11am.

WILL YOU HAVE ACCESS TO WIFI?

Yes. Our accommodations in Zion and have wireless internet.

DO YOU NEE Sheets?

No. Everything is included from linens to towels and everything in between.

ARE THERE ANY COVID-19 PROTOCOLS?
